

MINNESOTA FOOTBALL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS



HELMET AND FACE MASK

A helmet and face mask which met the NOCSAE standard at the time of manufacture.

Four-attachment point chinstrap properly fastened.

SHOULDER PADS

Jersey covering shoulder pads.

HOME TEAM GAME JERSEY

All home jerseys must be the same dark color(s) clearly contrasting to white.

JERSEY NUMBERS

Numbers shall be clearly visible and shall be on the front and back of the jersey. They shall be centered horizontally at least 8 inches and 10 inches high on front and back, respectively. The entire body of the number (the continuous horizontal bars and vertical strokes) shall be a single solid color that clearly contrasts with the body color of the jersey.

TOWEL

One moisture-absorbing solid-colored towel that is not ball- or penalty flag-colored; is no less than 4 inches in width and 12 inches in length; is no greater than 18 inches in width and 36 inches in length; has no more than one visible manufacturer's logo/trademark reference that does not exceed 2¼ square inches and does not exceed 2¼ inches in any dimension; and has no more than one school logo/trademark reference that does not exceed 2¼ square inches and does not exceed 2¼ inches in any dimension.

KNEE PADS as manufactured and worn over the knees.

CLEATS shall meet specification by Rule.

TAILBONE PAD as manufactured.

HIP PADS as manufactured.

THIGH PADS as manufactured.

PANTS covering the knees.

MOUTH PROTECTOR

A single mouth and tooth protector worn as designed.

GLOVES that meet the specification of Rule 1-5-2b.

VISITOR TEAM GAME JERSEY

Jerseys shall be white.

FOREARM PADS

Forearm pads must meet the NOCSAE standard or the SFIA specification at the time of manufacture.

SWEATBANDS

Moisture-absorbing sweatbands when worn on the wrist shall not extend more than 3 inches toward the elbow.

MANUFACTURER'S LOGO

One visible manufacturer's logo or reference is allowed on jersey and pants. Logo may not exceed 2¼ square inches or exceed 2¼ inches in any dimension.

OTHER ILLEGAL EQUIPMENT

Eye shade (grease or no-glare strips or stickers) that is not a solid stroke or includes words, numbers, logos or other symbols within the eye shade. Eyeshields attached to the helmet that are not constructed of a molded rigid material; or clear without the presence of any tint.

Jewelry is not allowed.

Religious medals or other religious items must be taped to the body and worn under the uniform. A medical-alert indicator must be taped to the body and may be visible.

Play cards not worn on the wrist or arm are illegal.

Uniform adornments may not be worn with the exception of one moisture-absorbing towel or sweatbands.
